1. Declarations of Interest – Cllr Williams declared an interest in 19/0127C.

- **2. Apologies for Absence** Apologies for absence were received from Cllr Beckham.
- **3. Minutes of the Meeting of 7**th **January 2019 Resolved:** The Minutes of the Meeting of 7th January were accepted as a true record of the meeting.

4. Planning Applications

- 19/0092C- JODRELL BANK OBSERVATORY Listed Building Consent for internal alterations comprising of removing partition walls and reconfiguring rooms - Comments due by 14th February 2019. *Decision - No Objection*
- **19/0127C** Fairfields, Blackden Lane, Goostrey Certificate of Lawful Proposed Use for part single and part two-storey extensions to the existing dwellinghouse. Proposed Outbuilding incorporating a swimming pool and gym. Comments due by 5th February 2019. Note: This application was not to the Parish Council.. **Decision** The Committee resolved to make no response.
- **18/6421D** 61, Main Road, Goostrey Discharge of condition 6 on approval 18/4723C Partial demolition of existing dwelling and construction of an extension. This appears to be a change of external materials. Comments due by 28th January 2019. Note: This application was not notified to the Parish Council. *Decision No Objection*
- **5. Sibelco Planning Application Update KM** KM attended the CW&C Planning Committee Meeting at Chester and spoke as an objector. CW&C have now approved the application but it has to go back to CEC in February. KM will speak at the CEC meeting if necessary but does not feel able to comment on the water table issues.

KM mentioned that particulate air pollution is the main cause for concern and monitoring should be a condition if CEC is minded to approve the application.

There will be a liaison committee for the Sand Quarry and Goostrey should have a seat on that committee to cover any ongoing issues.

After some debate the KM indicated that he felt that the Secretary of State would be likely to Call-in the application for his consideration..

6. Update on Planning Enforcement Issues

 Waste Site on Bridge Lane – CEC Planning Enforcement are currently working with the owners Planning Consultant and are also consulting the CEC Legal department.
