<u>THERE ARE NO RUBBISH EXCUSES!</u> - Before you use a waste skip company you must check that they are licenced to carry your waste and that they dispose of it at a licensed waste operator site. If you use unlicensed companies, you can be fined!

How to check for legitimate waste skip carriers/operators:

If you're looking to have waste removed from your property or business, a legitimate waste skip carrier/operator will always:

- Be registered with the Environment Agency and have a waste skip carrier licence which can be verified on the Environment Agency website at <a href="https://environment.data.gov.uk/public-register/view/search-waste-carriers-brokers">https://environment.data.gov.uk/public-register/view/search-waste-carriers-brokers</a>
- Provide a waste transfer note for removal of any waste on request (for example: following building or garden work)
- Provide details of the site license where the waste is to be recycled/disposed which can be verified
  on the Environment Agency website at <a href="https://environment.data.gov.uk/public-register/view/search-waste-operations">https://environment.data.gov.uk/public-register/view/search-waste-operations</a> (you can check the list of operators by authority ie Cheshire
  East or Cheshire West, which is easier if you don't have a specific name or location)
- Be able to provide proof of where it was taken in the form of an official weight ticket which will identify the disposal site

NOTE: Although there are plenty of local, licensed skip hire companies, there are NO licensed Waste Disposal or Recycling Sites in Goostrey or Holmes Chapel!
